



Jackson T. Wright Jr., MD, PhD, is Emeritus Professor of Medicine at Case Western Reserve University and former Director of William T. Dahms, MD Clinical Research Unit and the Clinical Hypertension Program at University Hospitals Case Medical Center. Dr. Wright has published extensively (over 300 articles, book chapters, and abstracts) and served on many national and international advisory panels addressing hypertension, especially in minority populations. His research experience includes having had a major or leadership role in a number of major clinical cardiovascular and renal outcome trials, especially those conducted in Black populations. Most recently, he was PI of one of the five clinical center networks and 1st author of primary results paper for the NHLBI sponsored **Systolic Blood Pressure Intervention Trial (SPRINT)**. Dr. Wright has also served on the four latest US national hypertension guideline panels, including the panel that authored the most recent 2017 ACC/AHA guideline.
